The winner will be notified on Monday, October 21.

Contest Rules:

1. Pumpkin must be real—not artificial
2. No pre-decorated/store bought pumpkins
3. Pumpkins can be carved, painted, or both

 - **All pumpkins must be received by 12 noon on Friday, October 18**
5. Include a card with your name, group/business name, pumpkin title & contact information
6. The winning pumpkin owner will be awarded a cash prize of \$100

After the festival, decorated pumpkins can be picked up either at 4:15 p.m. on October 19 at Pine Hill Park, or on Monday, October 21.
